

## 2nd ANNUAL PECK TRAFFIC SAFETY GOLF TOURNAMENT RULES

**SCRAMBLE:** All team players must hit their own ball and then select the best position/location of the four. Pick up the other 3 balls and take to the position chosen. All four players will then hit their ball from that location and select the best ball position again (and etc, to the green). Once on the green, players will select the one ball position they would like to putt from and all 4 players will putt from there (and etc. into the cup).

**NOTE:** the first ball to enter the cup is the score you post – so if the first person putting misses - and taps in, NO OTHER player is allowed to putt.

**NOTE:** Players may play their own ball from that ‘best ball position’, no more than ONE CLUB LENGTH from the ‘best ball position’ without improving the lie & no closer to the hole. In the rough, stay there! In the sand, stay there!

**LONG DRIVE:** Ball must lie in the fairway to be eligible.

**CLOSEST TO:** Ball must lie on the green from the tee box to be eligible.

**GIMME STRINGS:** Can only be used once and only one string per player may be used. Once and it is done!!

NOTE: For clarification, if a player has a 10-foot string and a team hits (say on a par three from the tee box) to within 10 feet of the pin - or inside the length of that string to the pin, it is considered a ‘gimme’ and a ‘hole in one’. Another example would be (say on a par 4), if a team hits their second (approach) shot to within the length of their gimme string from the pin, it would be considered an ‘eagle’.

However to be eligible for the **OFFICIAL HOLE IN ONE PRIZES**, a player must actually hit the ball in on one shot, from the tee box (USGA RULES). NO GIMME STRINGS

**PECK BALL:** On each hole, players must take consecutive turns playing the Peck Ball. Whoever’s turn it is to play the ball, that same player must play the ball throughout the complete hole and then and only then, it changes hands for the next hole. The team that holds on to the ball the longest will be awarded a prize at the end of tournament play. Be sure to circle the hole that the ball was lost on and which shot it was (in the case of a tie).

Unless stated here, **USGA RULES APPLY FOR THE ENTIRE TOURNEY.**

### CONTEST HOLES

- HOLE # 2 Official Hole in One (USGA rules-no gimme strings) wins Scottish Golf Holiday
- HOLE # 4 Hit your APPROACH shot (2<sup>ND</sup>) into ‘Peck’ circle on the green and win a T-Shirt
- HOLE # 7 Straightest Drive (from tee box) wins PRIZE
- HOLE # 8 Official Hole In One (USGA rules) wins Bahamas Cruise
- HOLE # 10 Long Drive (Men’s and Women’s) wins PRIZE
- HOLE # 11 Closest To the hole wins PRIZE
- HOLE # 13 Official Hole In One (USGA rules) wins Set of Golf Clubs
- HOLE # 16 **GRAND PRIZE HOLE IN ONE (USGA rules) \$25,000 PRIZE**
